You and your team members are responsible for creating a **double-spaced, typed** list of 15 items representative of the inhabitants of planet Earth that you would include on a **recordable storage device** traveling to another star system. Your list must include the following:

1. at least 3 scenes from Earth, no more than 2 of which can be from the United States
2. at least 3 spoken greetings, quotations, brief passages from written materials, and the language in which each is spoken, no more than two of which can be in English
3. at least 3 titles of musical selections, no more than 2 of which can be in English
4. a justification for every item you have selected and how it is representative of Earth as a whole, not you as an individual or as a citizen of Arizona or the United States

You may include pictures and/or information obtained from additional sources, however you **must** include all references used, even those listed by the instructor, and **type** this assignment in order to receive credit!
